SECURITY REPORT

05/10/2016 to 09/10/2016

INCIDENTS - LYNNWOOD NORTH AREA:

1. The Interactive control room received a call on Thursday afternoon at 15:00 from a resident in Rodericks Road of a suspicious white Quantum Combi with 5 x black males inside, with a reg. no. FF 41 PP GP, trying to gain access to his property. The resident confronted them and they claimed that they were from Telkom. After the client confronted them they jumped in the vehicle and drove away. The patrol vehicle and the Interactive high speed vehicle were doing extra patrols in the area to look for the suspects and the police were also informed.
2. The Interactive control room received a panic on Saturday afternoon at 13:49 from a resident's house in Millers Mile. The reaction vehicle was dispatched and upon arrival they found the gate standing open and requested backup. When backup arrived the guards entered the property and found the front door open and the domestic tied up. She was unable to confirm how many suspects there were or what vehicle they arrived in. The suspects were armed with a firearm and stole 2 flat screen TV's and a laptop. The gardener was working at the back of the house and was unaware of anything until the panic alarm went off. A case of armed robbery and theft will be opened with SAPS.

As the complainant pulled into the garage at the security complex where she lives she saw a white Ford Fiesta pulling into the yard behind her. Three unknown men, two of them armed and all wearing balaclavas threatened her. They fled with laptop, keys and cash. Incident occurred at 11:20. No registration number available.

INCIDENTS - OTHER AREAS CRIME HOTSPOTS:

1. The Interactive Security control room received an alarm from a business premises in Brooklyn Rd, Menlo Park. The suspect gained access to the office through the side door and stole 3x laptops and a laptop bag. Before the suspect broke into the office, he used a pool pole to steal a handbag off the kitchen counter from the premises next door to the office. A case of business burglary and theft has been opened with the SAPS.
2. The Interactive Security control room received an alarm at 14:15 Saturday afternoon from a house in Malabor Rd, Lynnwood Glen. Upon arrival the reaction vehicle noticed the gate standing open. He called for back-up. The guards found the boarder tied up inside with. 4 black males armed with fire arms and a homemade panga were involved. They gained access by lifting the gate off the rail and drove into the property. They stole 2 x flat screen televisions, a laptop and a cellphone. A case of armed robbery and theft was opened with the SAPS.
3. The Interactive Security control room received an alarm from premises in Bootes St, Waterkloof on Saturday evening at 23:11. Upon arrival the client confirmed that the burglary did not take place on his own property but on that of his neighbour. Upon inspection of the property, it was found that the electric fence had been cut to gain access to the property. A television was stolen but was recovered. A case of residential burglary was opened with the SAPS.
4. The Interactive control room received information that a Toyota Hilux Bakkie with a canopy, reg no. FRV 958 MP was stolen from outside a guesthouse in the Lynnwood area. It could not be confirmed where in Lynnwood it was stolen.
