SECURITY REPORT

09 - 11/06/2017

INCIDENTS - LYNNWOOD NORTH AREA:

- 09/06 - Armed robbery in smash and grab style, Kings Highway. The resident was followed home from Menlyn Maine. Three men in a grey Audi boxed the resident in from behind as he pulled into his driveway. The perpetrators smashed the driver's window, removed the keys from the car and threw them into the bush. They stole a Rolex watch and cell phone. All this took place on a busy street with cars driving past and no-one stopping to assist.
- 10/06 - Armed robbery, Queen's Crescent. At about 5:30pm three men, one armed with a panga and the other with a pistol, gained access to the property by lifting the gate off the rails and breaking the front door security gate. The elderly homeowners were there at the time and didn't hear a thing until the criminals confronted the wife in the kitchen. Two TV's were stolen and the suspects also demanded the keys for the owner's VW Polo. The keys were not on the property at the time.

- 10/06 - Attempted hijacking at the Investec crossing at Atterbury traffic light. The victim drew money from the ATM at Menlo Spar and was followed. When he stopped at the crossing, two men jumped out and stabbed him. Victim managed to escape.
- Acorn Street a stolen Jeep was recovered. Vehicle was left and escape was made over the pedestrian bridge.
 - Leyds Street, Muckelneuk. House break-in, laptop and 3 cellphones stolen. Suspects were caught and property was recovered from them. 3 arrests made.
