1. 2 x theft out of motor vehicle

3. 1 x murder. The deceased, according to eyewitnesses, entered the driveway at 16:15 on Saturday. A silver Volvo with unknown registration number and four black males stopped behind him. There was some altercation between the suspects and the victim. A shot was fired and the suspects fled. The victim passed away on Sunday morning.
4. 2 x business robbery.
Details of the one robbery is about ten suspects, some of them armed tied up the people inside the shop and then ransacked the place.
Two unknown men wearing construction clothing, both of them armed entered a jewelry shop. They ordered the people inside the shop to lie down. Display cases were broken and jewelry taken. Shots were fired inside the shop as well on the way out while they were fleeing. No one was injured.

INCIDENTS - OTHER AREAS CRIME HOTSPOTS:

1. On 24th October at 21:30 at House & Home, Menlyn Mall. 3 x unknown black male perpetrators wearing balaclavas gained access through the back of the store at the receiving side of the Grocery Avenue shortly after closing time. Forced a staff member at gun point to open the receiving wired mesh gate that leads to staff parking and main back gate for the store towards Palala Rd. One staff member did manage to alert mall security through the shopfront windows who called backup. Main gates were temp closed pending info on suspects' vehicle. Suspects never entered the mall but parked at Palala road receiving side. Took money, watches and cell phones from staff who were tied up with cable ties. Also electronic equipment stolen from the store. No description available on suspects' vehicle. Staff were sent home by store manager. He also arranged for counselling for them. No shots fired, no serious injuries. SAPS at the scene. Investigation underway.
2. Menlyn Mall: Theft out of NP200 the 24th of August at 18:06 at Grocery Avenue open parking outside New World. Laptop stolen after door lock was forced open. Suspects driving black VW Jetta. Controllers still checking footage for reg. no.

SAFETY ADVICE:

- Road users are requested not to expose themselves to unnecessary danger.

A MESSAGE FROM THE BANKS:

When a thief forces you to take money from the ATM, do not argue or resist, you might not know what he or she might do to you.

What you should do is to punch your pin in the reverse, i.e. if your pin is 1254, you punch 4521.

The moment you punch in the reverse, the money will come out but will be stuck halfway out and it will alert the police without the thief noticing. Every ATM has this feature which has specially been designed to signify danger and send a help signal.
