## SECURITY REPORT

### INCIDENTS - LYNNWOOD NORTH AREA:

The Interactive Security control room received a call at 22:51 regarding people fighting at the corner of Lynnwood Rd and Rosemary St. When the patrol vehicle and armed reaction vehicle arrived on the scene, they found the suspects to be drunk and requested back-up from the SAPS.

### SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES/PEOPLE:

### SECURITY AWARENESS:

Crime always rises over the festive season. Some preventative measures can be implemented (based on the recent modus operandi of criminals in the east of Pretoria including Lynwood):

- Ensure that your electric motor gate cannot be lifted off its rails with a crow bar (both sides).
- Do not assume that a high-end vehicle in excellent condition cannot be involved in housebreaking.
- Do not confront suspicious looking people. Rather notify your security service provider, CPF or SAPS. Suspicious people may be armed and desperate (drug dependency/abuse etc.)
- Do not get out of your vehicle if your gate at home does not open - drive off immediately and call your security service provider or friend/neighbour.
- Test your alarm with the help of the control room of your service provider. The battery of your alarm must be in a good condition for your alarm to function properly.
- Your trusted domestic worker can play a big part in the security of your residence and suburb. Please keep them informed and encourage them to pass on information of suspected crime and suspicious people and vehicles.
- Most burglaries take less than five minutes.
- Criminals poison dogs to commit crime. If you do not see or hear your dog (or your neighbour's dog) the first reaction is to go to investigate. Rather call your security service provider to investigate. Dogs do not attack if sprayed with pepper spray or some other chemicals.
- Discuss and agree on security measures with your neighbours.
